

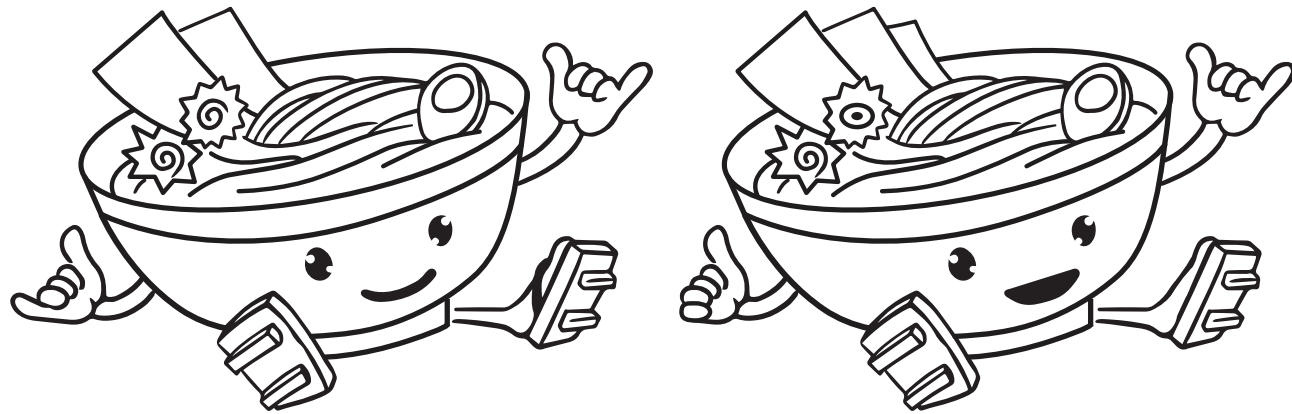
# Kaimukī Grinds
